



Individual Lot NPDES Permit Information

Who needs National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit coverage?

- Properties located within a Larger Common Plan (LCP), i.e. residential or commercial subdivision, not included in the original disturbance;
- Properties whose original NPDES Permit has expired;
- Properties in which the original permit holder will not allow the builder to sign on as a co-permittee;
- Properties which are not a part of a LCP and the disturbance is greater than an acre

What needs to be filed for NPDES Permit coverage?

- ✓ Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)
- ✓ South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control's (SCDHEC) Notice of Intent (NOI)
- ✓ Financial Responsibility/Ownership Form
- ✓ Completed Design Checklist
- ✓ York County's Land Disturbance Fees (\$125.00 per disturbed acre)
- ✓ SCDHEC – NPDES Permit Fees (\$125.00)
