

NOTICE OF ELECTION

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

COUNTY OF YORK

Notice is hereby given that a partisan Special Election for York County Council District 6 will be held on Tuesday, January 3, 2023 as fixed by law. One position for the office of council member shall be elected to serve the remaining portion of an unexpired four-year term.

Any person wishing to vote in this election must register no later than Sunday, December 4, 2022. Mail in voter registration forms will be accepted if postmarked by Monday, December 5.

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following Photo IDs at any Early Voting Center or Election Day polling location.

- S.C. Driver's License - Includes standard License and REAL ID
- S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles ID Card - Includes standard ID, REAL ID, & SC CWP
- S.C Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID - All Department of Defense Photo IDs & Veterans Affairs Benefits Card
- U.S. Passport & US Passport ID Card

If you have one of these Photo IDs, you are ready to vote. Voters should remember to bring one of these IDs with them to the polling place. Voters without Photo ID can get one free of charge from the Department of Motor Vehicles or their county voter registration office. Voters who encounter an obstacle to getting a Photo ID should bring their paper voter registration card without a photo with them to their polling place. These voters can then sign an affidavit swearing to their identity and to their obstacle to obtaining a Photo ID and vote a provisional ballot. This ballot will count unless the county board of voter registration and elections has grounds to believe the affidavit is false.
