



Summer Food Service Program Announces Operation Dates

York, SC-The York County Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) will be offered on Monday, June 5, until Friday, August 11. This is a federally-funded, state-administered program that reimburses York County for serving nutritious meals at sponsored sites to children and teens in low-income areas at no charge. The SFSP operates primarily during the summer months when school is not in session, and has operated in York County for the past 35 years.

At sponsored sites throughout the county, this program provides meals to all children 18 years of age and younger without charge. Acceptance and participation requirements for the program, and all activities, are the same for all regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, gender identity, or religion. Also, there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

Additionally, the SFSP continues to seek qualified individuals to assist in the goal of serving nutritionally balanced meals to children during the summer. The SFSP is seeking individuals who are passionate about serving their community; as well as, able to follow directions, complete paperwork accurately, and perform accurate record keeping.
