



## York County Resurfacing Roads through the C-Fund Program

**York, SC-** Beginning Monday, April 10, the York County Engineering Department in conjunction with Granite Contracting will begin conducting C-Fund resurfacing projects across the county. These resurfacing projects will tentatively be done within 90 days; contingent upon weather and other items. Listed below are the roads that will receive resurfacing (in order of completion):

- Belle Meade Drive	Northway Drive to end of County line maintenance
- Normandy Way	Entire Road
- Malvern Drive	Middleton Place to Poinsett Drive
- Hilldale Drive	Banbury Lane to Ferncliff Road
- Creek Crossing	Hitching Post Lane to cul-de-sac
- Amberside Drive	South Bank Drive to cul-de-sac
- Covenant Place	Gallent Court to Alden Court
- White Ridge Drive	Gordan Road to cul-de-sac
- Spring Hill Court	Osteen Road to cul-de-sac
- Kinglet Road	Black Highway to cul-de-sac
- Riverfront Road	Entire Road
- Caroland Drive	Pine Bluff Court to cul-de-sac
- Horse Shoe Trail	Pleasant Road to Saddle Ridge Road
- Lake Vista Drive	Hwy 160 to Rockmont Drive
- Vandora Springs Road	Entire Road

Drivers should expect delays due to only one lane being open during the paving process. Drivers need to drive slow, look out for workers and proceed with caution in these areas during this time.

The C-Fund Program is a long established partnership between the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) and the forty six counties in the state to fund the improvements of state roads, county roads, city streets, and other local transportation projects. Funding is derived from a 2.66 cents per gallon of gasoline user fee that is apportioned to York County from the total amount of C-funds collected statewide based on certain criteria.
